The Corona pandemic, The Ukraine war still going on, the energy crisis, it effects and touches all of us.



SIAMA was founded in April 1970 in Switzerland and consisted of • SIAMAS (Society for the interests of active Missionaries in Asia) • SIAMAF (Society for the interests of active Missionaries in Africa) • SIAMSA (Society for the interest of active Missionaries in South America) SIAMA is presided by Reverend M. Fiedler and secretary Mr. L.W.A.

Ruygrok. The secretariat was in the Netherlands. Services were also rendered through appointed agencies in Asia and Europe.



1975 - 1980 SIAMAS - SIAMAF -SIAMSA have been merged to one Society SIAMA

INSIGHTS INTO WHEN TO BOOK FLIGHTS?

WE ARE HERE TO HELP!

SIAMA is a specialist in air travel for Missionary and humanitarian charitable purposes. SIAMA is not a regular travel agency. We are a Christian Society and operate non-profit. SIAMA values the shared Christian identity and principles with its members and works exclusively with Missionaries and humanitarian workers since 1970. SIAMA is a transparent service-oriented organization. SIAMA's mission is to provide Missionaries with the best professional, personal and true-hearted advice and service to ensure Missionaries attain the best tickets available for their care-free travel.

Today, there are so many sources to book travel around the world. We have to be realistic and clear on this. SIAMA can not be "price" competitive for every routing in the world. We can offer you good prices on one way and multiple stopover trips, but for simple roundtrip tickets airlines regularly stunt with their prices and these cannot always be beaten by us. However we are always willing and helpful to challenge these prices for you.

If you book relatively close to the departure date (less than 1-2 months before) the SIAMA Missionary fares will usually become more attractive than the average online fares, but still it is a puzzle for the regular passenger when and what to book. Sometimes fares differ per booking website, travel agency or per country (currency). Fares also depend on space availability and the date of booking is also important. It all can make a difference.

Economy class tickets are usually divided into multiple booking classes. For each booking class the airlines want to have a certain turnover. If the flight does not fill up quickly enough and the occupancy rate of the flight is lower than average, they will revise their fares and booking classes or do some promotion



In that period, if you are lucky you can book cheaper tickets. All this information is kept secret and you cannot be sure cheaper fares will become available in the future. Airlines make this on purpose hazy. Now comes the tricky part: It is possible to make reservations about 11 months prior to departure. If you think that if you book well ahead of time you will still get the lowest possible booking class, you are mistaken. Some Airlines have the strategy to block the cheapest economy class seats until closer to departure. If their flights are fully booked at a certain time, they will not offer the cheapest economy class anymore and only the next one, which will be more expensive.



In the end, it is still the passenger who decides when to book. We understand it is sometimes hard to understand why one to you as we think it is important to time you have a better fare for this and later on it seems to be totally different again. Also it is hard to understand that the passenger sitting next to you in the plane has maybe paid USD 200 more or less than you did, but it happens! Sometimes it is wise to book well ahead of time and the other time you may be lucky with booking a last minute ticket at a really cheap fare. On the other hand if you wait too long, you can end up with paying much more. It is difficult and at one time you must decide and book what is best for you and be happy with that. We honestly like to help you to make the best decision and choose the itinerary/ fare that works best for you.

If that means you will end up not booking with SIAMA we are more than willing to assist you on your next trip, although we do appreciate of course, if there is a minor price difference, that you reward our hard work and assistance if you book through SIAMA so we can continue to support you and other missionaries around the world.

Please always remember SIAMA as a true-hearted professional and helpful source to check for air tickets. We are dedicated to you and to what you represent. We admire what you do and are thankful to do our part to help you, save you time and money for care-free travel to your Mission field and this way we hope your funds can be used for other worthwhile matters in your Missionary/humanitarian work. You make a difference to the world with your Christian dedication and helpfulness to mankind. We like to make a difference Serve you! We are thankful if you make use of the services of SIAMA, as one of your travel providers, and offer us the opportunity to assist you and book the best possible fares for you. This way, we can continue to exist and negotiate for better fares/conditions in the future with the Airlines. The benefit of that is going straight back to the Missionary community.



SIAMA SOCIETY

SIAMA is a Society and not a regular travel agency. SIAMA does not see you as one of our customers, but as one of our partners in the missionary and non-profit development field. Therefore we invite you to become a member of our SIAMA Community!

The Society is based in Leiden (since 25-11-22), is nonprofit and its purpose is to assist the SIAMA members in their objectives on Missionary, humanitarian and nonprofit development work.

It is our goal to Serve those who Serve and assist all members with their needs for travel, information or advice.

SIAMA membership is a requirement for travelling with us, as our contracts with the airlines are based on these memberships.

Membership is USD 25/EUR 25 (individual, couple or family) and is valid for 3 years. It is not necessary to become a member for requesting fares. We will only charge this with your first booking with SIAMA.

TRAVEL OPTIONS

SIAMA can assist you with travel for:

INDIVIDUAL TRAVEL

(for single persons/couples or families)

When you have travel plans, you can contact us by email for price information. We will search for best still available flights/fares for you and send +3 proposals. One with most direct connections, and 1 or 2 based on Missionary fare with flexible conditions and if there are better fares with strict conditions, we will also include that for your consideration. We use this as a start to find the best itinerary to your liking.

GROUP TRAVEL

For groups (10 or more passengers on the same flight itinerary) we can offer special group fares. Our experienced Group Travel coordinator will work with you to obtain the best group air fares possible. Let us set up the right itinerary and search for the best dates to obtain the best price for your next group event.

Some Tips for Planning:

- •Some airlines will offer cheaper fares for mid-week flights.
- Fly during off-peak seasons (February-March and September until November).
- Book early, reservations can be made 10/11 months prior to departure/return dates.
- Waiting for last minute deals is not a good idea when you want to travel with a group.



ROUND-THE-WORLD-TRIPS

Always wanted to make this special trip? See how your Mission projects from your past are doing, or visit friends/fellow Missionaries from previous posts? Visit that country or special city you never had the time or opportunity to visit before?

Round-the-world fares are a speciality of SIAMA. When you intend to travel, ask us which countries/cities you would like to visit on your way back home or v.v. CONFERENCE TRAVEL

The Flight Path for 2023


Over the past few years, air travel organizations in general has seen their fair share of turbulence. Air traffic demand surged due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the Russian war on Ukraine and the energy crisis. Despite the fact that there are still enough challenges, there are also bright spots on the horizon. This gives us space to look ahead and focus on the future. Our prospects for travel in 2023 are:

• Airlines are recovering from their bad results in the previous years and their flight schedules are now almost back to normal.

• Airline fares are more unpredictable than ever, especially with the present climate and energy crisis.

• It is likely airline fares will increase and new/higher taxes may be levied in the near future.

• General advice: make bookings for 2023 as early as possible to avoid unpleasant surprises later on.

RESERVATION **PROCEDURE:**

1. Send us an email or fill in the form on our website www.siama.nl and make sure to give us the name of your Mission/Organization or purpose of travel.

2. Give us your desired routing, travel dates and if you also need child/infant fares

3. Indicate if you have preferences on airlines or an airline alliance and/or if you are flexible with your travel dates.

4. Within one working day (at least 95%), we will send you a selection of the best available options for your travel.

5. In general we check for the best fare for the most direct routing, best fare based on flexible conditions on changes and cancellation and 1 cheapest fare available irrespective of both.

6. After that we can go back and forth to answer any additional questions you may have.

7. When you are ready to book and happy with one of the offered schedules and fares, we will make the reservations and send you the confirmed schedule and invoice with our payment instructions.

8. If you wish we can also send the invoice to your organization.

9. Upon receipt of your payment, we will send you the tickets by email.
