A story from one of our members

Introduction

We like to thank Janet from SIM in West Africa for a glimpse in her missionary expertise.

What inspired you to dedicate your life to missionary/humanitarian work?

I have always seen my work as a school teacher for 28 years in Australia as my ministry and enjoyed this very much learning to lean on God each day for wisdom in hard situations. After my parents died I had the privilege of travelling through Africa for a couple of months and had prayed that if there was something I could do in my retirement in Africa that God would show me that. I had intended to return to my work in Australia until I retired. In a very round about way God led me to work in West Africa in a hospital away from the city teaching the missionary children of the doctors and other missionaries at a Hospital. I gave up my job in Australia and have worked in West Africa now for 12 years.

What are the most rewarding aspects of your work?

Seeing the children I teach thriving in an environment that is different from their birth countries and doing well in school. Building relationships local people.

What are the most significant challenges you've faced in your work?

The temperature here on the edge of the Sahara is very hot in the hot dry months and still gets warm during the cooler months. Teaching a group of children from the age of 5 to 12 without having a curriculum worked out can be very challenging but is much better when there is another teacher.

Being wise in trying to understand and embrace looking at life through the eyes of a different culture.

Can you share a specific story that has deeply impacted you?

I have had the privilege of meeting with some local families through the hospital. These families have become good friends and we have been able to share many aspects of our lives together over the many years I've known them and through them I have met many other children.

What advice would you give to build stronger global Christian connections?

Get involved with specific missionaries and support them in prayer and other ways if possible. People praying is a fabulous gift. Ask questions and listen to what is happening and pray for specific things. Spend time with people when they visit their home country appreciating that they have another life that they return to and what that means for them. Just be friends and don't put missionaries on a pedestallf you are interested in working overseas look at different organisations and speak to people who can guide you towards your possible future and pray about it and ask friends to the same.

How do you envision the future of global Christian connections?

We have always lived in a world that is forever changing. There has always been conflict between countries and different beliefs. Now, I see a trend in empowering local Christians to be reaching out to their culture because locals have less barriers to get through. They may have similar stories and will have an understanding of what locals really believe. If there comes a time when certain nationalities have to leave then the work can continue. There is also a trend of missionaries coming from even more countries to the mission field. God has a plan for workers from everywhere to be used in his work.

Traveltips

When you need to travel soon, remember to check our extensive checklist on our website: https://www.siama.nl/international-travel-checklist/ Underneath we list a few more travel tips, which in our opinion can be helpful or good to know:

Just before travel:

- For your own safety. Do not write your address on luggage tags. Just list your contact telephone nr. and email. If luggage goes missing, airlines will call/ email you when found.
 Make sure your electronic devices
 - are fully charged before the flight.



During or after travel:

- Flying can be stressful and uncomfortable and with just a simple item like a tennis ball you can make it more pleasant and enjoyable. Using a tennis ball as a massage ball will help improve your blood flow, muscle tension during landing and take off. If you are interested, we advise you to check on internet for more information about this life-hack.
- Wear compression socks.
 These help minimize swelling on and after your flight by increasing blood circulation.
 At a minimum, they can keep you more comfortable, but more importantly, reduce the risk of developing blood clots during a long flight.
- Pack a nasal spray. Have you ever noticed a generally icky and dry feeling in your sinuses while flying. Stay hydrated.
- Take your own bottle of water with you and some snacks as back-up as provide airline food/drinks are not always plenty.
- 6. Take flyfit earplugs with you.
- Buckle your seat belt over your blanket, so that it is still visible. In case of turbulence, flight attendants will not have to wake you up, to check.
- Do not leave boarding passes as rubbish in the passenger seat pockets.
 Criminals can scan the QR code to get your full name and other details and even steal your mileage points.



History of SIAMA

1970-1975

SIAMA was founded in April 1970 in Switzerland by Reverend Fiedler and Mr. Leo Ruygrok and consisted of:

SIAMAS (Society for the interests of active Missionaries in Asia)

SIAMAF (Society for the interests of active

Missionaries in Africa)

SIAMSA (Society for the interests of active Missionaries in South America)

1975-1980

SIAMAS-SIAMAF-SIAMSA have been merged into one Society:

SIAMA (Society for the interests of active Missionaries Abroad)

1980-1985

SIAMA services are now operated only from the Netherlands and Leo Ruygrok is President of SIAMA. Telex was introduced in 1982.

Until then bookings were made only through mail and personal visits in the field.

Els Langezaal joined SIAMA in March 1983 1985-1990

Our cooperation with several airlines started; Lufthansa, Air France, KLM, United Airlines and British Airways.

First trip field trip for Els with Mr Leo Ruygrok to meet many Missionaries in Kenya, Tanzania and Zimbabwe and after that many more in other countries.

1990-1995

Fax is introduced, a huge blessing to Missionaries. Travelplans could now be made closer to departure. Tickets were safely delivered by DHL. There was a lower demand in air travel worldwide due to the Gulfwar in 1990–1991.

Still many Missionaries travelled to/from their Mission field anyway. Mr. Leo Ruygrok passed away in 1992 and his wife Betty

continued as President SIAMA.

1995-2000

The introduction of email is huge break-through in our communications. In 1998 SIAMA expanded to 15 staff members and moved to Pieterskerkhof in Leiden.

2000-2005

The 11th September 2001 was a black day and shocked the whole world. This terrorist action had a severe impact on aviation.

2005-2010

The yearly SIAMA Bulletins are now available digitally on our website.

In 2009 Betty Ruygrok retired but still active with SIAMA Children Namibia, a childrens home in Omaruru. Els continues the services of SIAMA together with other dedicated staff.

2010-2015

Although there are an increasing number of online sources for booking air tickets, SIAMA members continue to book through SIAMA. Especially Star Alliance and British Airways with their Flexible conditions for Missionary tickets have proven to be a good partner of SIAMA.

2015-2020

SIAMA started to work with American Airlines and Iberia. The alliance partner of British Airways (One World). SIAMA moved in 2018 to Kanaalpark 157, 2321JW Leiden.

2020-2025

In April 2020, SIAMA marked its 50th anniversary amid the onset of the Corona pandemic. We were able to help many missionaries return home safely in March 2020, just before the global lockdowns began. It was a challenging time for everyone worldwide, but SIAMA persevered.

Betty Ruygrok former President of SIAMA passed away in March 2022.

We made a fresh start in 2022 with a new SIAMA logo and computer system and were eager and fully equipped to assist you with your travel plans again!

Due to the pandemic, we couldn't celebrate our 50th anniversary, so nowwe are giving extra attention to our 55th year anniversary."


